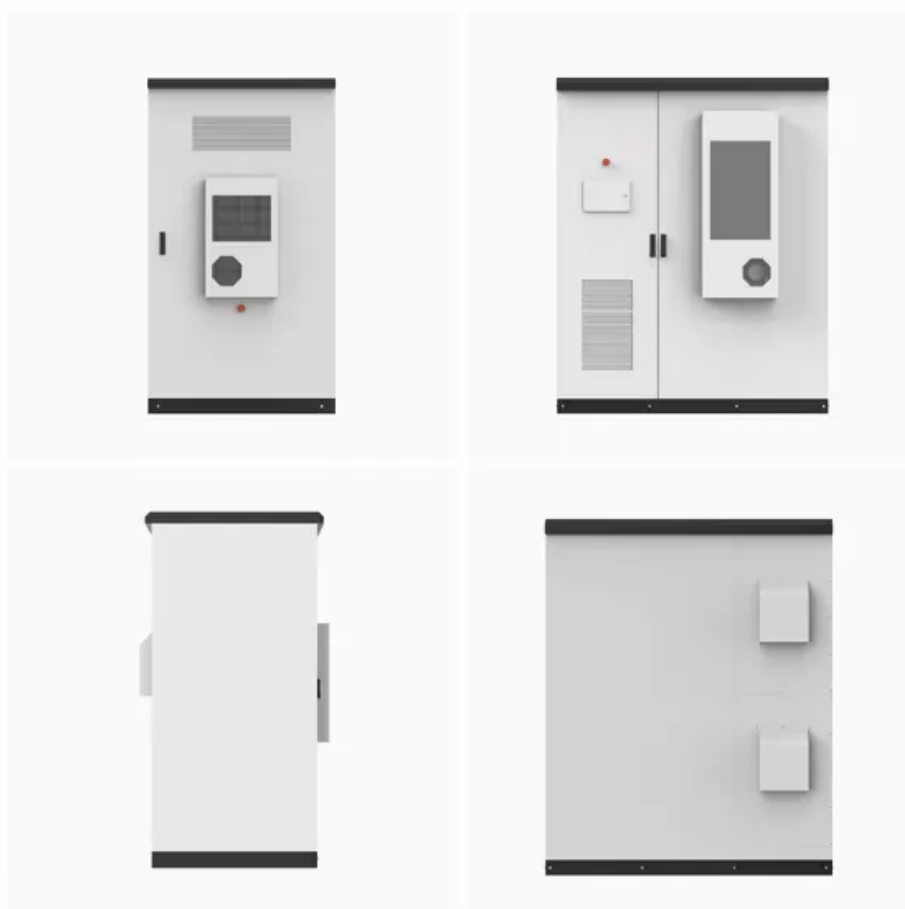

Solar savings are location-dependent but universally strong: While homeowners in high-rate states like California and Hawaii can save \$3,000-4,000+ annually, even moderate-rate areas typically deliver \$1,200-2,400 in annual savings with 6-10 year payback periods.
