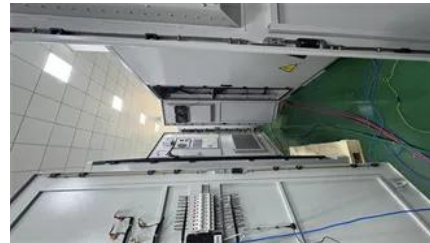

The overall objective of NDC 3.0 is to reduce the carbon intensity of the Tunisian economy in 2035 by 62% compared to the reference year 2010, as illustrated in the following graph:

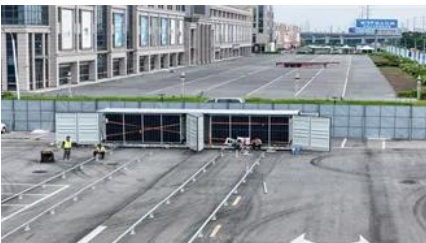
