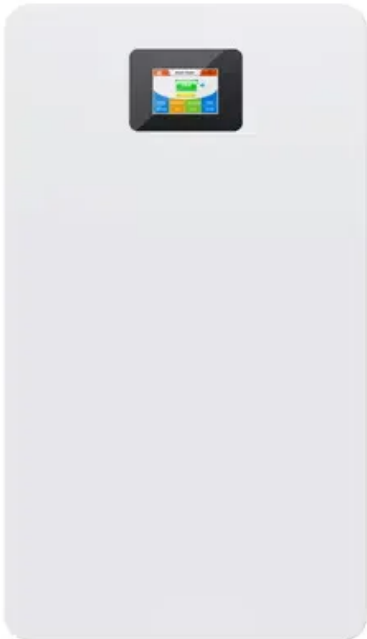


Turkmenistan s second batch of energy storage power stations
